CHURCHILL, ROOSEVELT & STALIN: WARTIME Three" settled issues in World War Two Churchill attended 16 wartime conferences (FDR 12, and Stalin 7) 1939-43 Churchill traveled 111,000 miles by ship and by plane Pearl Harbor, December 7, 1941 Britain gains another ally Churchill and McKenzie King set the date for invading France in 1944

Remember -Although these 3 leaders were on the same side ...

- Roosevelt had died and was replaced by Truman -much more aggressive and anti Stalin / Communist This was important as Roosevelt had maybe been a bit too soft on Stalin previously?
- Churchill had lost the election in Great Britain and was replaced by Clement Atlee who's priorities
