Limited potential for normal binocular vision and good stereopsis Infantile exotropia usually exhibits a large, constant deviation (generally 30-80PD) with associated ocular motility disorders Rarely amblyopiogenic because of alternating fixation pattern, but provides limited potential for normal binocular vision and good stereopsis
